- Approved the March 31, 2010 L RTP Subcommittee meeting summary
- Reviewed the 2035 L RTP Transportation Alternative #2 – the Public Alternative

- Received a presentation on the local road section of the Long Range Transportation Plan by Volusia County staff. Noted that they would try to provide the information on the local roads which is to be included in the L RTP prior to the May TCC meeting
- Discussed the SIS project list and how the I-95 six lane widening project, from SR 44 to the Brevard County line, is not in FDOTs cost feasible plan

  - A stop at the airport as part of the commuter rail expansion project

**B) REVIEW AND RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF THE TRANSIT PLAN APPROACH FOR THE 2035 LRTP**

**Background Information:**

On Monday, May 10, 2010, the MPO Staff hosted a workshop for the MPO Board and members of the MPO's 2035 LRTP subcommittee. The discussion covered the issue of transit, whether or not transit services should be included in the 2035 LRTP, and if so, how do we pay for it?

After the two hour workshop, the elected officials present, along with members of the LRTP subcommittee, recommended that MPO staff draft language to the effect that the LRTP will include a locally generated, dedicated funding source for transit. The Board members directed staff to provide overall cost estimates for the transit projects identified in the two LRTP alternatives as well as what the revenue estimates for various increments of a transportation surtax.

The LRTP subcommittee will be addressing this issue at its next meeting.

**B) REVIEW YEAR 2035 TRAFFIC MODELING RESULTS FOR TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE #2 – THE PUBLIC ALTERNATIVE AND REFINE THE COMBINED TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE**

**Background Information:**

In previous meetings, members of the Volusia County MPO developed Transportation Alternative #1 for inclusion in the region-wide traffic model. Transportation Alternative #2 – the Public Alternative, was also developed as a result of the Make Your Mark in 2035 public outreach effort.

At the April 21, 2010 meeting, LRTP Subcommittee members gave direction to staff for developing the combined alternative.

A presentation of the traffic model results from Transportation Alternative #2 will be given. The results will be mapped using the same method preferred by committee members to review Transportation Alternative #1 (congestion displayed by comparing the ratio of estimated traffic volume to roadway capacity). The LRTP Subcommittee will discuss this information along with other factors that may be used to refine the year 2035 LRTP.

An updated transportation project table will be provided at the meeting. Information needed to update the table was not available when this agenda was developed.
