A) REVIEW THE YEAR 2035 LRTP TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE #2 – THE PUBLIC ALTERNATIVE

Background Information:

Between January and March 2010, the Volusia County MPO held 13 “Make Your Mark in 2035” planning events around Volusia County, involving 200 participants. Information collected at these events was used to develop Transportation Alternative #2 – the Public Alternative.

Volusia County staff will make a presentation regarding the refinement process for the local road list and the financial estimates that will influence this work.

D) REVIEW TRAFFIC MODEL RESULTS FOR TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE #1 - THE TECHNICAL ALTERNATIVE AND CONTINUE REFINEMENT OF THE YEAR 2035 LRTP

In various meetings between December 2009 and February 2010, members of the Volusia County MPO developed Transportation Alternative #1 for inclusion in the region-wide traffic model.

At the March 31, 2010 meeting, LRTP Subcommittee members were provided with the results of the year 2035 traffic modeling forecast based on the set of transportation improvements included in Alternative #1 (congestion displayed by comparing the ratio of estimated traffic volume to roadway capacity). The LRTP Subcommittee will discuss this information along with other factors that may be used to refine the year 2035 LRTP.
